NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

The regatta will be governed by:

- The rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing to,
- Annex E of the RRS 2009-2012.
- The rules for the equipment of vessels (ERS)
- The federal regulations championships and national rankings concerned
- The system of French courses HMS into force on 1 January 2009

2 ADVERTISING

The race is a category C advertising in accordance with Article 20 of the ISAF Regulation as amended by Regulation of advertising FFVoile.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND REGISTRATION

3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the class Marblehead

The number of competitors allowed to participate in the test is limited to **76**.

A maximum of **12** places are reserved for foreign competitors

In case the number of applications exceeds the number of places available, the selection committee of the national VRC select participants in the French order of ranking national runners on 31 october 2010.

3.2 The nominations, along with the costs of incorporation File (+ 40 Euros + booking meals, see attached form) made payable to Club Nautique Ploërmel must reach the organizer before March 20, 2011 midnight (stamp postmark) to:

3.3 Competitors who reside in France at the time of registration :

- Permits FFVoile 2011 with the stamp valid medical and accompanied by parental permission for minors
- The certificate of measurement of the boat, validated by the national leader of the gauge;
- The stamp of the association of class 2011

3.4 The foreign unlicensed FFVoile must have a valid insurance for liability coverage with a minimum amount of 1.5 million Euros.

4 SCHEDULE

4.1 Confirmation of registration:

On April 1st from 14h to 19h00 and April 02 from 8:00 to 11 am.

4.2 Gauge and Control:

Prior to the confirmation of registration and delivery instructions from race each competitor must present a certificate of boat measures and identify and present all material that may be used during the championship according to the rules of class (indelible stamp specific to this race). Competitors will have to submit all materials: (hull, keel, ballast, rudder, sails, etc..) Clean and dry to the person responsible for this identification that is not a gauge.

There will be no preliminary meeting to gauge for not measured boats, however, the gauge of boats should be verified at all times of the competition, at the request of the Race Committee or the Committee Protest.

4.3 The Time of 1st warning signal of the first race is 13:00 on April 02 2011.

Schedule of courses and / or fleet each day (1st warning signal a fleet to stop the navigation of a fleet):

April 02 from 13h00 to 18h00: fleets to follow

April 03 from 9:00 to 15:00: fleets to follow

It will not be given a warning signal for a new race on April 3 after 15:00.

5 RACE INSTRUCTIONS

The race instructions will be available upon confirmation of enrollment.

6 ROUTE

The routes are of type 1 or 2 specific for HRV

The Race Committee may use other routes if the route types for HRV are not compatible with the water and / or wind direction.

7 TERMINATION

7.1 The point system will be applicable in the event of the HMS

7.2 The number of races to be run to validate the race will be 3.

8 DISCLAIMER

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see Rule 4 of Chapter 1 of the RRS 2009/2012 court decision). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage, injury or death, as part of the race, both before, during and after the race.
